RoHS and REACH Compliance

RoHS

Products manufactured and supplied by Superior Products, are in compliance with the RoHS European Union's Directive with regard to restricted hazardous substances based on information provided by our raw material suppliers, known substances utilized in our in-house processes, and any outside vendor(s).

All of our compressed gas copper alloy (brass) fitting products comply with the European Commission Directive 2011/65/EU known as "RoHS" per Annex item 6c allowing the exemption for "copper alloy" (brass) not to contain more than 4% lead.

Brazed assemblies are also in compliance of this Directive per Annex 7a, allowing high temperature solders (for melting temperatures greater than 1000° Fahrenheit required for most compressed gas equipment) which allows more than 85% lead where there is no viable lead-free alternative identified at this time.

REACH

Products manufactured and supplied by Superior Products are considered "articles" and not substances or preparations where substances or mixtures could be released. We do not add or use any of the 161 substances of very high concern (SVHC) listed by the European Union in the REACH candidate list, 12th update, issued 17, December, 2014.

We realize RoHS and REACH are both under constant review with continuous changes and will continue to monitor and maintain awareness of any changes to requirements with our material and service vendors.
